NOTES FROM OUR HANDICAP CHAIR

Dan Nelson, our handicap chair, asked me to pass on the following information:

1. When we play a tournament, we play the ball down unless Renee and Nick approve winter rules because of bad weather and that is a 6" bump, not lift, clean, and place. We only use lift, clean and place when specifically authorized by the Tournament Director and / or President. I noticed a new member on another hole picking up his ball to identify it at the Micke Grove tournament. Members to be very careful about touching their ball as it could lead to a disqualification, if I recall our tournament rules correctly.

2. Almost every tournament I have noticed mistakes by our members when we get the score cards. Addition of total scores and deduction of handicaps are resulting in wrong scores being reported. As everyone knows, Renee does not check our cards; she records scores from the signed and attested cards. Each individual should check their own score on the score card before it is signed and turned in. The discrepancies have resulted in some people not getting their proper score. It has not been a problem with pay outs to winners yet, but it easily could.
