#### Golf Rules

Once you're on the green and putting, do you always mark your ball? Do your playing partners? Golf Rule 11 notes that, if a putt from on the green hits another ball on the green, the putting player is charged with a 2-stroke penalty. Ouch! That can really hurt your score. So, be sure to mark your ball immediately before anyone putts and make sure that your playing partners do the same. Golf is hard enough without extra penalties!
